

STATE AMENDMENTS

Question 1: The Background Check Initiative

- **Yes Vote Means:** Every gun sale gets a background check beforehand. This closes loopholes for purchases at gun shows, online sales & other small private sales. Exemptions for transfer or gifting to family members.
- **No Vote Means:** Loopholes for gun purchases will continue.

Question 2: Tax and Regulate Marijuana

- **Yes Vote Means:** People aged 21-and-over can use & grow small amounts of pot. Marijuana will be regulated and taxed at 15% rate, to fund education & healthcare.
- **No Vote Means:** Marijuana possession stays illegal as a felony. This also contributes to the disproportionate mass incarceration of people of color. No extra \$ for education & healthcare.

Question 3: The Energy Choice Initiative

- **Yes Vote Means:** Ending energy monopolies' rigid power grabs and letting Nevadans directly participate in the clean energy economy. This initiative would establish an open, competitive energy market where people or companies could buy and supply electricity from other states or providers, instead of being limited only to the local utility.
- **No Vote Means:** The status quo.

Question 4: No tax on durable medical equipment including oxygen tanks

- **Yes Vote Means:** Creates a new special tax break that benefits a particular industry & group of its customers. A medical equipment company owner spearheaded this initiative.
- **No Vote Means:** The above doesn't happen. (Initiative must pass in 2016 & 2018 to succeed.)

Questions 5: Fuel Revenue Indexing

- **Yes Vote Means:** Clark County continues indexing of fuel taxes to the inflation rate through Dec. 31, 2026. That money is for nearly 200 street & highway improvements over the next decade.
- **No Vote Means:** We'll get \$ for those transportation needs off the money trees that grow here.

Catherine Cortez Masto (D)

As Nevada's Attorney General, Cortez Masto earned widespread praise for her crackdown on human trafficking, domestic violence, and mortgage fraud. Her priorities as U.S. Senator include: help students get an education without a lifetime of debt, end *Citizens United*, raise the minimum wage, and protect Social Security & Medicare.



Joe Heck (R)

Congressman Joe Heck is currently one reason why the GOP controls the U.S. House of Representatives. Described as a polarizing ultra-conservative, Heck has voted to kill solutions for climate change, helped shut down our federal government over Obamacare, supports *Citizens United*, and personally opposes gay marriage.

U.S. HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES

District 1

Dina Titus (D) is the incumbent. Described as a pioneer in clean-energy policy who wants Nevada to be a renewable energy powerhouse; early supporter of medical marijuana; gun owner who supports strong gun laws; opposes Yucca. Her challenger is attorney **Mary Perry (R)**.

District 3

Danny Tarkanian (R) is a far-right ultra-conservative who's been stumping for Donald Trump. Tarkanian wants to outlaw abortion even in cases of rape & incest, and build a wall" between Mexico & the US.

Jacky Rosen (D) is a community leader with a software developer background; supports immigration reform with citizenship; and pledges to work to create good-paying jobs.

District 4

Ruben Kihuen (D) is a rising star state senator. Kihuen supports a higher minimum wage, common sense measures to close dangerous gun law loopholes, and immigration reform with citizenship. **Crescent Hardy (R)**, aka Tea Party Hardy, is extremely conservative. Sympathizes with anti-government types like Cliven Bundy; supports cuts to social insurance systems; and isn't a fan of government sponsoring things like healthcare.
